Pelham Specialty Training was founded in the early 1990's to train EMTs and Paramedics. Since then Pelham has developed strong business relations with the United States Military and Fortune 500 corporations. In 2009, Pelham was asked to provide a series of courses for the Department of Defense. Pelham brought in a number of instructors who had strong backgrounds in military and law enforcement special operations. From this series of courses the Tactical Division of Pelham Specialty Training, was born. The mission of the Pelham Training Tactical Division is to provide specialized training and specifically designed products aimed at closing the gap on preventable law enforcement and military deaths.

One of the core tactical courses at Pelham Training is *Officer Down Rescue*. Every year a number of law enforcement officers and civilians are wounded and cut off from emergency medical treatment. For many agencies, the answer in such a scenario is to simply wait for SWAT to arrive. Yet, there are times when that plan is not acceptable, and action must be taken. Statistics show too often when an officer is down, comrades react in spite of departmental policy and without having received training in safely affecting a successful rescue. This is the very training gap Pelham's tactical courses targets.

In addressing this gap, Pelham exposed additional unsettling facts. First, few officers carry any medical supplies. Second, even fewer officers carry the knowledge to treat a traumatic injury. Third, while many squad cars carry some form of "first aid" kits, these kits are far too bulky for officers to keep close at hand and are not intended for treatment of a life threatening injury. Thus, Pelham created training and a true field trauma pack specifically designed for law enforcement officers.

Developing The Pelham Trauma Pak

The Pelham Trauma Pak draws heavily on the United States Military's experiences of treating injuries in combat situations. Three items are noted above all others as being instrumental in saving lives in combat: the tourniquet, the chest/abdomen seal, and appropriate wound packing material. There are many excellent options for each of these items on the market which allowed us to create the smallest field pack possible without compromising the quality and functionality of the contents; a goal that lead us to some very specific products, all of which offer to the end user the highest quality and functionality.

The Trauma Pak

The end result is a specifically designed trauma pak that fits neatly into the plate pouch of an officer's concealable body armor or pants pocket and measures roughly 5x7 x 1/2" and weighs less than 7 oz. The standard Pelham Trauma Pak retails at \$24.00 and contains: a versatile use SWAT-T tourniquet, z-fold packing gauze, and two chest/abdomen seals. Pelham Trauma Paks can be upgraded with hemostatic gauze or larger chest seals per preference. CPR masks, gloves or other items can be included upon customer request. Pelham Training hopes the competitive pricing encourages police agencies to outfit the entire department. For the value, we hope individuals consider the purchase of a Pelham Trauma Pak as an additional investment toward ending every shift safely. Through training provided in our 1 day *Field Trauma Care For Police Officers* and 2 day *Law Enforcement Tactical Trauma Course* and quality trauma care supplies, Pelham Training hopes to close the gap on preventable in-the-line-of-duty deaths.
